An introduction was received from the Chairman and a reminder of the Council's expectations for the audio or visual recording of this meeting. Councillor Jones confirmed that Councillor Allen would be standing down as a councillor with immediate effect and thanked him for his contribution

2024/131 Declaration of Interests
